

## **Zanzibar Association of Tourism Investors**

1. The Covid-19 testing lab in Zanzibar is at Mnazimoja only and Dar Salam as a back up plan. However other hospitals like Global and Alrahma have been trained to collect samples as intermediary between the lab and guests.

2. The lab is approved by the Ministry of Health and also the WHO hence it will be recognised internationally.

3. For tourists there are two options:

3.1. Option 1 is to do the test in PHEOC - Migombani (Mnazimoja Hospital outsourced the test station)

3.2. Option 2 is to do the test in Global Hospital

### **The procedure for this is as follows:**

3-4 days before you are due to fly, you need to take a COVID 19 test.

### **Option 3.1. COVID-19 TESTING FOR TRAVELERS**

**Location:** PHEOC - Migombani

The centre is located at previously CPS building opposite Military Camp & NMB Atm.

**Time:** Services will be provided everyday from 7:30AM-5:30.PM.

Requirements:

1. Date of entry.
2. Date of Departure.
3. Address of Hotel in Zanzibar or place of residence in Zanzibar.
4. Your telephone number.
5. Email address should you wish to receive your certificate via email.
6. Copy of your passport.
7. Your test payment receipt.

### **Fees:**

1. Tourist/Foreigner: \$80.
2. Locals: Tzs. 30,000.
3. Residents: Tzs.45,000.

USD Account: 0708288000 .

TZS Account: 0707968000 .

Visa card use allowed.

Note:

Travellers & drivers or any one in their company must wear masks as they visit the testing centre to protect those working there.

Test results is still within 72 hours. (Minimum 48hrs - Maximum 72hrs )

### **Option 3.2. Test station in Global Hospital**

The cost is 100 \$, you can pay by credit card. You will get the result after 4 days. If you need it faster you must pay another 50 \$.

The test station is open from Monday to Friday from 8.00-15.30; they are closed on Saturdays and Sundays.

Both test stations will take the test using swabs as per international regulation. They will take your contact details and the results of the test will be issued within 72 hours.

You will be contacted by the laboratory on Whatsapp with a photograph of your certificate.

If your result is negative, just show the certificate as you check in with your airline at Zanzibar airport.

Those that test positive will have to undergo treatment as stipulated by the Government and only issued certificate once fully recovered.
